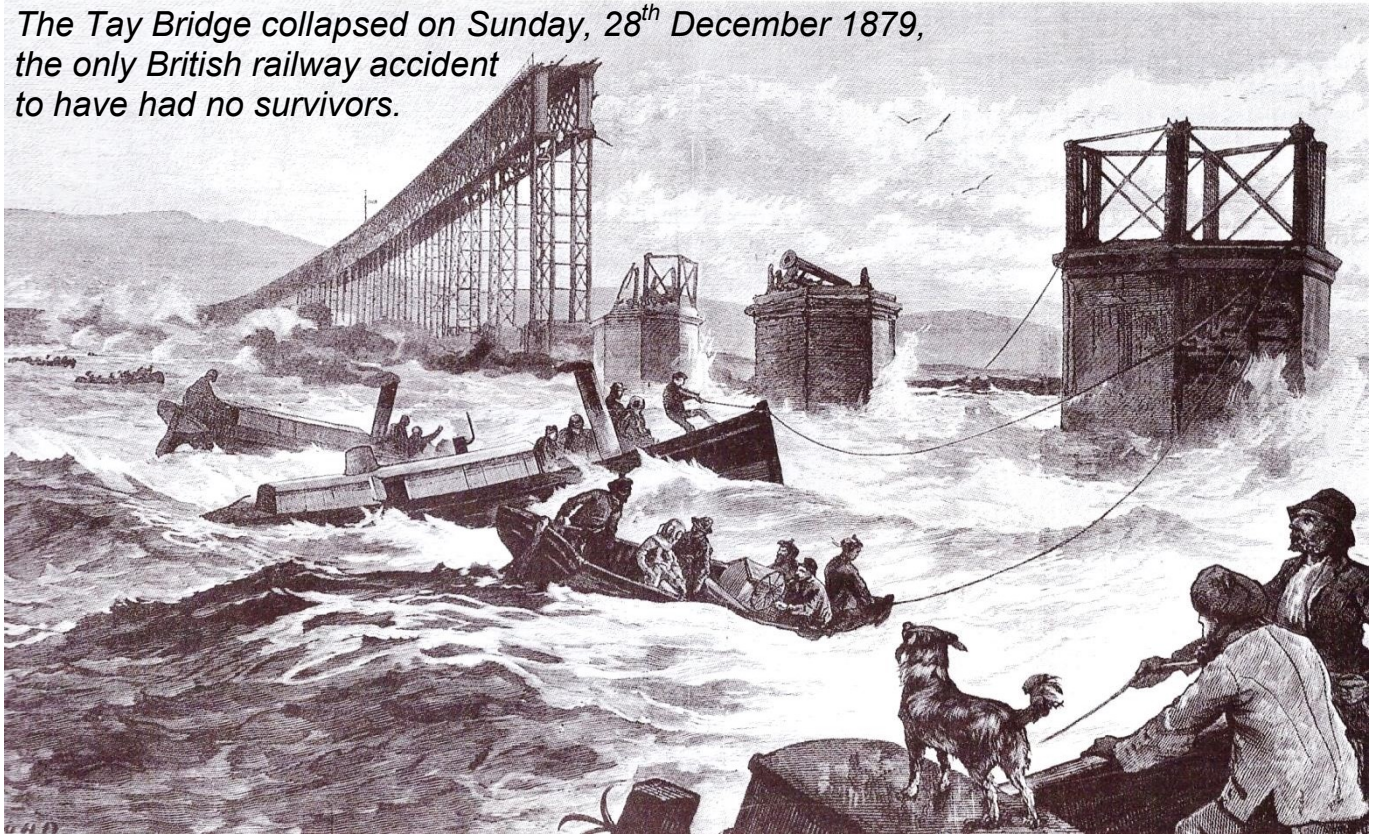




FRIENDS OF PUDSEY ROLLER
